

Large Easy Brick Quilt Instructions

Approx. finished size - 56" x 70"

You will need **twenty five bricks** (rectangles) that are approx. $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $20 \frac{1}{2}$ "

- 1) Choose four of the "bricks" to cut in half horizontally (approx. 10 ¼" each) for each of the tops and bottoms of the seven columns. You will have one of these ½ rectangles left over.
- 2) After planning your layout as illustrated, sew the seven columns, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "bricks" per column. Use a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam when sewing. Press seams between the bricks.
- 3) Sew the columns together. Press.
- 4) To prevent the seams from opening, either backstitch outer seams or staystitch \%" around the perimeter of the top.
